Care Locker provides practical hygiene and basic care resources to the trusted people already helping children in our community.

What Care Locker is

Care Locker helps children access hygiene and basic care items through trusted community partners.

The Need

Some children go without these essentials because of circumstances outside their control. In Polk County, about **1 in 6 children lives in poverty**.

How it Works

Care Locker supplies trusted community partners who already know and serve children. A designated Care Contact helps identify what items are needed. Care Locker restocks each location once a month based on the needs being seen in the community.

Items may include

Toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, conditioner, washcloths, deodorant, period products, and other basic care essentials.

How this can children

- Helps us understand what items children may need most
- Helps us learn what gaps trusted adults are seeing
- Helps us plan supplies based on real community needs
- Helps us support partners without adding more stress
